

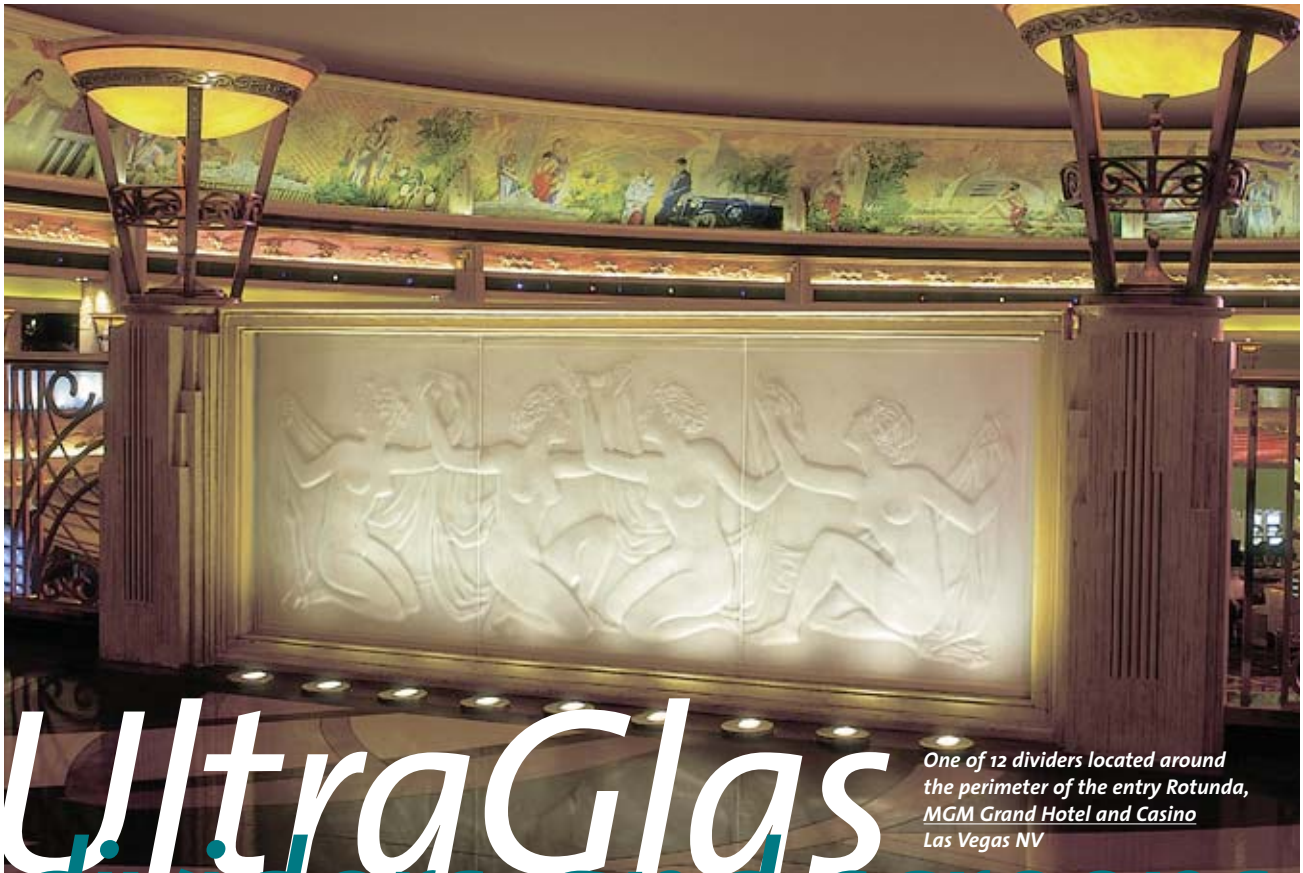

Creative latitude — think of UltraGlas dividers and screens as an opportunity to put the perfect finishing touch on your space — to extend your visions, while providing diffusion and privacy, without interfering with light transmission. The list of possible applications is virtually endless. You may wish to incorporate a wide variety of textures, designs and even finish options to coordinate with or otherwise complement the space in which the element will reside. You may choose to make a simple, organic statement, utilizing a subtle combination of standard architectural textures (as illustrated on page 1) — or you may prefer a more dramatic result, in which custom molds are hand-carved to illustrate virtually any subject (see above). Most anything that can be conceived and illustrated can be artfully interpreted in UltraGlas.

Functional and decorative options — UltraGlas can provide you with all the creative options that you are likely to need. A simple, yet dramatic, Lalique-like finish (as shown above) might provide the perfect finishing touch. You'll find a wide selection of glass tints (through-body glass colors), create precise shapes (up to 69-1/2" x 119-1/2") and configurations, thickness (up to 3/4"), opaque or translucent finish colors (permanently fired into the glass), decorative edge treatments and an endless variety of applique possibilities. And they're all low maintenance.
