**How to specify a special shape or edge** — UltraGlas can create virtually any desired shape, including ovals, oblongs and even unusual or combined shapes, in sizes up to 69-1/2" x 119-1/2". Edge shapes may also be specified — see the shaped edges (above), that have been combined with a series of serpentine bends. Simply provide an actual-size template or scale drawing.
